First Baptist Church - Laurel, MT

This year we again had a float in the Fourth of July parade in Laurel. Many helped to put together 3,000 literature packets to hand out on the parade route. This was 1,000 more than previous years, and we found out that we could have used another thousand! The three youth camps at Castle Rock were held from the 10th-29th of July. Evangelist Kyle Gilstrap delivered good messages to the different age groups all three weeks with many decisions. Others who served all three weeks were our camp missionaries, Mike and Beth Payton planning to minister in Nicaragua, and his friend, Jamie Jackson who is beginning a ministry in Youth Evangelism. They all proved to be blessings in all three camps, as well as preaching powerful messages on two Sundays at 1st Baptist. The 10th-15th of July were the dates of Senior High Camp with Pastor Jim Barrick of 1st Baptist, Cody serving as Dean for his 17th year. Their were 27 campers attending and many good decisions during the week. The 16th-22th were the dates of Intermediate Camp. As this was a transitional year prior to Evangelist Mike Fisher becoming the Program Director for all 3 camps the last two camps reflected this. Mike was able to serve as the Program director for this camp with Pastor Dosson of Faith Baptist, Lodge Grass as the Pastor for the camp. There were only 20 campers present, tho it was different in that there were only 5 girls, but 15 boys. There were several salvation decisions- one of the boys from our church brought 3 friends with him and each made a decision for Christ! The 23rd-29th were the dates of Junior Camp with Pastor Widdis serving as Program Director and Bro Sheldon Scheerer as Camp Pastor. This camp had the most campers present with 23 girls and 19 boys. There were 2 decisions for salvation and 1 for Baptism. A very good week was had for all. August 14th-17th a work crew came from Iowa! Mike Fisher recently spent time in Iowa where he met Pastor Josh Appel and his Dad, Jim. He talked to them about the improvements which were being made at Castle Rock and they decided to come out with several men to contribute to the work in the first part of the week of men' retreat. they were a blessing as several cabins got new porches and the floors of the 2 bathrooms upstairs in the Lodge had new tile floors. Jim Appel continued on these projects and the others took part in the retreat. Many thanks to all! August 17th-19th The annual Men's Retreat/Trail Ride was held at Castle Rock. There was a record attendance with 45 men and boys participating with Pastor Walt Widdis as Dean and Pastor Kurt Eikenberry, of Jericho Baptist, Gillette, Wyoming, bringing the evening messages, Danny Clement brought the morning devotions.
