The story of 60 years "Under the Big Sky" at Castle Rock Baptist Camp

One of the great men of God in the Old Testament of the Bible is the man Caleb. His words are recorded in the book of Joshua as he told how in spite of opposition he had "wholly followed the Lord". Later he showed his great faith in the Lord even though he was up in years by stating in Joshua 14:12 …"Now therefore give me this mountain, whereof the Lord spake in that day".

This Biblical story of Caleb reminds us of three men who sought the Lord sixty years ago for a place to begin a summer Bible camp. They wanted to help the youth and adults of the churches of the Inter-Mountain Baptist Fellowship. These three pastors were Pastor Arthur Allen, Pastor Fay Garner and Pastor Felix Runquist. God led them to a summer camp that was for sale and they were able to buy the 14 acres and some buildings for the miracle price of \$15,000.00. The camp is located in the Gallatin Gateway area of Montana under the beautiful towering Storm Castle Peak.

The first summer of camping at the new Castle Rock Baptist Camp was in 1961 with 285 in total attendance for all weeks of camp. The total grocery bill was \$909.77 with the cost per meal of \$0.24 cents. The cost for a week of camp that first year was \$10.00. As you can see "times have changed" but the main emphasis is still on the teaching and preaching of the Word of God.

This summer we are celebrating the 60th anniversary of Castle Rock Baptist Camp. Through the years there have been many changes to the once "run down" property. Several beautiful buildings have been added as well as numerous improvements. Nearly every week during the summer you will find a group of young people or adults enjoying God's wonderful creation while being encouraged through the Bible. That is why we call this place that God has provided a Bible camp. Over the years hundreds have received Christ as Savior and many are serving the Lord around the world because of the influence of this ministry. Please pray that God will continue to bless this historic place that He has used for His Glory located "under the big sky".
