## **IMBF PASTORAL HIGHLIGHTS**

Honoring those who serve among us and with us

Pastor Devon Dosson Faith Baptist Church, Lodge Grass, Montana I Psalm 121

The Lord called me and my family to Lodge Grass in 2010. At the time we served the Lord as missionaries in Bolivia, South America. While on furlough we made a trip to Montana for meetings and a family trip.

As a young boy my dad worked as a cowboy and we lived in Lodge Grass on two separate occasions. While we lived in Lodge Grass we attended an American Baptist Church where my mom taught Sunday School. As time passed, my parents became convicted that the church was not what it should be. Several other families felt the same way and eventually left to form

Faith Baptist Church. In August of 1983 at the newly formed Faith Baptist Church I heard and understood the Gospel and recognized that I had never made a personal decision to trust Christ as my Savior. I was 14.

On furlough in 2010 we visited friends in Lodge Grass and I preached at Faith Baptist Church. During this visit I learned that their pastor resigned and that they had been without a pastor for 3 years. I did not know it but God had arranged this meeting and would eventually call me to Lodge Grass to pastor Faith Baptist Church.

Now the Lord had to show me that He was directing my steps. When we visited Lodge Grass that June of 2010 we were scheduled to fly back to Bolivia in July and resume our ministry there. Our tickets were already purchased and we had big plans for our return. We returned to Bolivia, prayerfully seeking God's will. In August or September I received a call confirming that the church had met and voted to extend the call for us to return to the States and move to Lodge Grass.

After liquidating all of our belongings in Bolivia we flew back to the States. Arriving back in Michigan we packed everything that we had in a pickup and 12 foot trailer and arrived in Lodge Grass for the first Sunday of December 2010.

One of the things that missionary deputation and living in a foreign culture teaches you is that God is faithful. I knew that if God was in this move He would take care of all the details, all I had to do was to be faithful and obedient. He providentially provided a young family to take our responsibilities in Bolivia, the same family that filled in for us during furlough. They were a perfect fit.

God handled so many details that confirmed over and over that we were in His will. One of the first needs that I saw was the need for more space at the church. We were so limited in what we could do because the church consisted of basically one room.

The many miracles that God performed to allow us to add on to the church are too numerous to mention here, but suffice to say He allowed us to build a beautiful new auditorium and remodel the old church into a fellowship hall with new bathrooms and a nursery.

God is ever faithful and though we have lost some good people due to various circumstances God has brought new folks in.

In 2020 God allowed us to be involved with a church plant back in our hometown of Breckenridge, Michigan where my family lives. It has been a joy to see God move and supply all along the way. In the last two years God has put together a good group of about 50 people, called a full-time pastor, and given them a building that is over half paid for already.

This year we have been involved with developing our audio visual capabilities as well as pouring concrete for a handicap ramp, and parking space. We have revival meetings planned for the end of August and the first of September. I am excited to see what God has in store for Lodge Grass in the next ten years. And maybe He will allow us to be involved in another church plant in the near future.

Whatever it is, God is faithful.
