#### **WINGS AS EAGLES**

Lesson # 3 - Taking the High Road - Isaiah 40:31

For those that "wait upon the Lord" Isaiah 40:31 gives us the promise of renewed strength and eagles wings. What a blessing to know that the Lord will provide for us a way to soar above all of the tumult of this present world. He gives us a way to "take the High Road" in life and not let all of the noise and problems beset us.



In the legend of the Eagle and the Crow there is a truth that would do us well to remember. The crow sometimes flies up on the back of the eagle and sits and pecks the neck of the eagle while in flight. The eagle does not fight back nor waste strength by responding to the attack of the crow. Instead the eagle spreads its wings and rises higher and higher in the sky. As the eagle with the crow riding on his back gains an extremely high altitude the crow has to dive off the back of the eagle for lack of oxygen. We need to apply this story to our lives. When the crows of life come along to attack us, let us mount up with eagles wings and not respond in kind to their attack. Let us learn to "take the High Road." Just quietly keep ascending and even though the crows might be along for the ride they will soon give up and fall off. Do not let them distract you but "keep your eyes on Jesus" and keep rising above and beyond. "Take the High Road" with God!

Here are some real life examples and how we should respond. 1. When someone says something unkind to us, "Take the High Road" and do not respond in kind. 2. When someone says something about us that is a lie or wrong "Take the High Road". 3. When a coworker tries to put us down to elevate himself





First Baptist Church 400 Seventh Avenue Laurel, Montana
