Now we begin to understand what the Lord is trying to teach us. The result of following through in obedience to the first three aspects of this verse is now to enjoy "The Supernatural Power of God." That is evidenced in being able to "Run, and not be weary" and "Walk, and not faint." This all becomes a "Supernatural Experience." It is a three-fold process. It is growing in grace and endurance hand in hand with God. Many times when we start out it is like flying as we "Mount up with wings as eagles." Then as our experience and trust in God increases we begin to "Run." And then as more "victory in Jesus" is achieved we "walk." All of this is accomplished with the "Supernatural Power of God." Ultimately, we discover that it is in the "walking" and not in the "flying" that our faith triumphs.

I think of the person who trained for a 26 mile Marathon. They trained four months with hours of preparation running 500 miles for a race that lasted 3 hours and 52 minutes. Sadly, we can train for a 26 mile marathon but never prepare for the race of life. It is really a lifetime marathon and should be prepared for with great diligence. We do this by daily "Walking with God" so we can "Walk and not Faint." We need to "Practice our Faith" which is "Living out our Faith." We need to

strengthen our prayer life by "Waiting on God" in prayer. We also need to "Rest in the Lord" which is "Being still and knowing God."


